

AGE OF ABSOLUTISM (CH 16) Monarch Résumé

<u>Directions</u>: You will choose one of the monarch we have been discussing in Chapter 16 in Global History. You will research that person's life and create their résumé. I have given you the résumé of Henry IV, another famous person in world history, to model yours after. You may use your own template for the résumé; you don't have to use the example of Henry's.

A <u>résumé</u> is a piece of paper that tells a prospective employer about a job-seeker — who they are, what experience they have, and why the employer should hire this person.

Do the research of the monarch on Thursday, 12/8 and create the résumé on Friday, 12/9. We will be in the computer lab both days in class. The completed résumé is **due on Monday**, 12/12/10.

Each Résumé should include the following as shown on your example:

**A picture or painting of the monarch at the top of your paper.

- 1. Monarch & name of Palace where spent most of time.
- 2. <u>Objective in life</u>: what do they <u>want to accomplish</u> for their country & personally? Quote of that monarch would be helpful, too.
- 3. Experience: what makes that person qualified to be a monarch?
- 4. <u>Accomplishments</u>: <u>what have they done for their country</u> for which they will be remembered? What are they proud of?
- 5. <u>References</u>: at least <u>3 people who can vouch for the character</u> of that monarch. These people should know the monarch & can testify to their ability to rule but should NOT be related to the monarch (no parents or spouses).
